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New Brunswick Home Care Curriculum

Standards (NB-SC)

Our NB-SC training standard Curriculum outline is available by contacting the NBHSA office.

The NB-SC curriculum is a condensed outline of requirements, proposed method of presentation, allowable time frames for completion, and actual curriculum modules with specific details of learning outcomes.

The NBHSA, the Department of Social Development, and Post-Secondary Education, Training and Labour worked together for several years to attain the core competencies required for caregivers to serve vulnerable citizens at home. NBHSA has been given the authority to manage the course distribution and alignment for trainers.

If you choose to be a trainer using your curriculum which will need to be aligned with the NB-SC curriculum outline the NBHSA will guide you through the months ahead to meet the Program Committee requirements.

Organizations that are on the Approved List of Trainers must submit their requests to align their courses to meet the NB-SC Curriculum to receive requisitions from the Department of Social Development. DSD will be requiring evidence of training this year to sign the 2014 contract.

Home Care agencies who train employees can choose the full NB-SC curriculum at \$1,000 or the Bridge to PCA at \$100. The Bridge to PCA will give you the right to teach the introductory sessions to the PCA certificate. Training institutions that do not have home care services are expected to request the NB-SC curriculum license at \$3,000 per year. Included with your signed license will be the Bridge to PCA book and the Curriculum book. Extra Curriculum and Bridge books will be available at a nominal cost.
