

Need Long Term Care for Yourself or a Loved One?

Long-term care services are important in New Brunswick because of a growing population of seniors. Long-term care refers to services which help seniors continue to deal with day to day activities as they are made more difficult by physical or mental disabilities.

How do I access Long-term Care Services?

Receiving LTC services is voluntary. It is your choice. For an evaluation of your needs, you must contact your Regional Office of Social Development. Someone you trust can be with you during the evaluation.

Who will pay for my Long-term Care Services?

LTC services are not covered by Medicare. Your income will be considered in determining what you will pay. The government may provide financial assistance to those who are unable to pay the full cost of their services.
